A270 Roomscapes Adapter Kit for Cubbies

Recommended Use

Intended for adapting the Community Cubby system to the Community Playthings Roomscapes system. The Roomscapes Adapter Kit can be used to connect Roomscapes shelves, panels, or gates and doors to the Community Cubby system.

Assembly

Your Roomscapes Adapter Kit comes in one carton containing:

1. Two Roomscapes Adapters.
2. This Product Guide.

To connect the Roomscapes Adapter:

1. Place the Roomscapes Adapter over the cubby connector. (Fig. A)
 2. Press the latch firmly shut. (Fig.B)
 3. Repeat to cover the bottom connector
- Two Roomscapes Adapter boards are required per side.*

To add a Roomscapes post, slide it over the Roomscapes Adapter dovetails.

⚠ CAUTION

- ▲ Add 32" posts to the Roomscapes Adapter unless the next shelf or panel is higher. In that case employ posts matching in height to such next unit.

To disconnect the Roomscapes Adapter:

1. Remove Roomscapes posts from Roomscapes Adapter.
2. Insert a key or screwdriver into the slot under the latch and pry the latch out. (Fig C)
3. Finish disengaging latch and take Roomscapes Adapter off the Cubby side.

Maintenance

Periodically inspect for secure connections, cracks, breaks, loose parts, missing parts, and/or malfunctions. Remove the product from service when any condition develops that might make operation unsafe.

Cleaning

Wipe with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use excessive water.

Construction

Solid maple with a clear nontoxic finish and engineered plastic parts.
