Recommended Use

The Book Box attaches to any 22" side of a MultiTable or MultiDesk. The open top design helps children find what they need and keeps their desk tidy. The unique under-table ledge makes an excellent place to store pencils, calculators, and other small items. (The side-mounting design allows maximum under-table room.) This product is intended for indoor use only.

Assembly

Your book box comes in one carton.

If your shipment is incomplete, please call your Customer Center.

To attach book box to table:

1. Unscrew one table leg (**Figure A**).
2. Slide Book box into place (**Figure B**).
3. Re-attach leg (**Figure C**).

Maintenance

Periodically inspect for cracks, breaks, loose parts, missing parts, and/or malfunctions. Remove the product from service when any condition develops that might make operation unsafe.

Cleaning

To clean your Book Box, wipe with a moist rag and mild detergent. Excessive water can damage the finish.

Construction

The wooden components are manufactured from durable hardwood plywood and solid maple and finished with a clear finish. All edges and corners are rounded for safety and ease of cleaning.

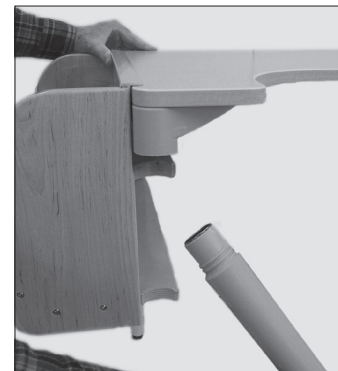
