If your shipment is incomplete, please call Customer Service.

Follow the instructions below for each leg:

1. Insert leg into plastic socket.
2. Rotate leg clockwise until it is completely tightened into socket. Use both hands to tighten.
3. When all legs are installed, stand the table on its legs. If table wobbles, check that the legs are fully inserted into the sockets.

Maintenance

Periodically inspect for cracks, breaks, loose parts, missing parts, and/or malfunctions. Remove the product from service when any condition develops that might make operation unsafe.

Cleaning

Wash with mild dishwashing liquid or powdered detergent and warm water, using a soft cloth. Rinse with warm water, and dry with a soft cloth.

Construction

Table Legs are solid maple covered with a clear wood finish.

Plastic parts are constructed from durable polypropylene.
